APPLICATIONS & ADMISSIONS

We take the following groups: Kindergarten (Ages: 2 to 3), Middle (Age: 4) and Reception (Ages: 4 and 1/2 to 58).

For admission into these classes, applicants should furnish the school office with following:

1 Completed application form with P200.00 registration fee

- 2. A photocopy of the child's birth certificate
- 3. Photocopies of the latest school reports

4. A photocopy of the health card, showing child's immunization in the case of children aged 6 or less.

- 5. Two recent passport-size photographs
- 6. Copy of Omang/ID (parent/legal guardian)

7. If you are not citizens of Botswana, you should provide the necessary document prove that you and your child are legally residing in Botswana.

8. Entrance Assessment We have assessment sessions which features shorter, more game-like activities and simplified scoring procedure.

9. Class sizes: Pupils are placed in classes of 15 to 25 children, with 2 Teachers.

HOMEWORK

All pupils in the school are required to do some homework at home. Children will I issued with a homework diery that will help monitor their homework on a weekly basis and on demand. Parents/ Guardians should use this cliary to communicate progress on homework or other issues at all times.

TRANSFER/WITHDRAWAL

If a student is to be transferred to another school or decides to stop School, it is vital that the school be notified In writing.

- a. The student should give one term's notice and then:
- Return all school property
- Have a Clearance Form completed
- The parent should
- Sign an official withdrawal form in the school office.
- Ensure all outstanding school fees are settled.



SCHOOL FEES

Regent Hill International Preschool School is a private school that relies on fees paid by Parents/guardians to Pay its staff, purchase resources and finance other activities. RHIPreS Is operating a pre-paid system of Paying fees. Therefore, Parents/Guardians are required to Pay up all term fees before the beginning Commencement of the term.

Parents/Guardians who do not pay before this scheduled time will be requested to keep their Child at home Until the payment is honoured. Parents/Guardians who default in payment of Fees may be handed over to The school's debt collectors and will have their child's classroom Schedule interrupted. After an absence from School for twenty-one (21) consecutive days, The child will be withdrawn from school. There is a non-Refundable registration fee of P200.00. For new students. 

BANKING

NOTE

2. Fees for the current term must be cleared before any payments can be credited for the Next term.

The name and class of your child should be clearly stated on any deposit slips! If the deposit Slip is lost and the name and class of your child had not been narrated on the deposit slip, Your account may not be credited with the payment.

- 6. You can also pay by swiping at the school. For safety reasons, the school does not accept Cash payments.
- 7. WE REQUIRE A FULL TERM'S NOTICE IN WRITING BEFORE YOUR CHILD IS CONSIDERED WITHDRAWN FROM THE SCHOOL. A one-month notice in writing may be accepted if Sufficient supporting evidence as to the reason of transfer is provided with the transfer Request. REFUNDS WILL BE PROCESSED TWO WEEKS AFTER A REQUEST IS MADE.
- 8. The registration fee is non-refundable. School fees may be refunded if they have been paid in advance and meet the terms stated under Transfers/Withdrawals.
